The LGPI Board met in a special session today to discuss interim administrator Jon Nelson's report (available on the LGPI website) and to provide direction on LGPI's future.

The Board was unanimous in its support of continuing LGPI's services. The following actions were authorized.

- Begin recruitment for the Executive Director and labor relations staff positions immediately. LGPI has two labor relations staff vacancies and, recognizing our members' need for these services, our goal is to fill the position(s) as soon as possible. We will be asking for your help in identifying individuals who should be considered for the Executive Director and labor relations positions.
- Revise the LGPI governing agreement between AOC and LOC including an expanded board and revised governance model for increased membership participation. This important work will also begin immediately.
- Pursue collaboration initiatives with CIS, such as investigation protocols and the identification of other areas where personnel and risk intersect and may have competing interests.

LGPI currently has one staff attorney who will continue to provide technical assistance and other support work. We ask for your patience and support as we move as quickly as possible to hire staff and meet your labor relations needs.
